

Student Dress Code

Liberty Christian School students are expected to follow standards of cleanliness, neatness, and modesty in everything they wear. Students are best prepared for school when they are properly dressed and groomed.

Uniforms are mandatory for both boys and girls. By enrolling a child at Liberty Christian School, parents are expressing their intention to accept and observe the school's uniform dress code. All articles of the uniform must be the French Toast brand. French Toast is available for online purchasing or may be bought at stores such as Target or Mervyn's. Older students may need to find clothing comparable to the French Toast styles. All articles of clothing must be on the approved uniform list unless stated otherwise. If for any reason a child cannot be in uniform, please send a written explanation prior to the child attending class.

Uniform Infractions

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Written Warning

3rd Offense: Parents/Guardians will be asked to supply the child with the articles need for the appropriate uniform before child is allowed back into class.

Articles that are inappropriate such as jewelry, hair accessories, etc. will be collected by the teacher and kept until the end of the school day.

Free Dress Days

Free dress days are a privilege for students and may be individually or collectively suspended or canceled if abused.

Every last Friday of the month is "Free Dress Day." The final week of school is "Free Dress Week."

These are days in which the children can express their individuality and also be creative. Each "Free Dress Day" will have a theme. All students are encouraged to participate. There are limitations to what the student can wear. They are as follows:

- All clothing must be neat, clean, modest, and size appropriate.
- All clothing must be in good condition, not torn or worn out.
- Denim pants or jeans are allowed.
- Walking length shorts may be worn.
- Sweat suits and weather appropriate sweaters or jackets are allowed.
- Shoes are to be worn at all times. No sandals.
- No bare midriff, spaghetti strap, low cut or tank tops.
- No shorts/pants below waistline, mini shorts or miniskirts.
- No clothing with inappropriate graphics, language, or inferences.

The success of the "Free Dress" privilege depends upon the exercise of good judgment in the part of the students, as well as, support from parents and guardians. The school reserves the right to determine whether or not a student has complied with the "Free Dress Day" code.
